

On November 14 and 15, 2007, PAHSCI held its second annual Administrators' Retreat at the Penn Stater Conference Center in State College, Pennsylvania. Thirty-two administrators from twenty PAHSCI schools were in attendance.

Tim Lucas, Professor of Practice, Lehigh University, co-author of "Schools That Learn," facilitated the sessions. The focus of his presentation was titled, "Tools for Schools That Learn: Constructing a Sustainable Program." Participants had multiple opportunities to interact, collaborate, and reflect on issues related to *Personal Mastery*, *Shared Vision*, *Mental Models*, *Team Learning*, and *Systems Thinking*.
